
What has the 41.5 Board been up to?

CC&R Rewrite

- Why is this needed?
 - Our current CCRs are very old and outdated
 - We've had budget for a CCR re-write for many years
- What is the current status?
 - HOA board engaged a real estate lawyer Spring 2013
 - Based on your feedback, CCRs underwent a major rewrite in the Fall of 2014 to remove any non-essential language and add back some features from our original CCRs
 - HOA board has a 4th generation final draft of the CCRs from the real estate lawyer.
 - We have spent around \$5k out of budgeted \$20k for this project and expect filing fees to be under \$100.
- What are the next steps?
 - Mailing another hardcopy in June/July timeframe with a ballot
 - Please vote and return the self addressed/stamped envelope!
 - If we don't receive a majority of votes in the mail, the Board will go doorto-door.
